



Aspen Forge Case Studies

Cedar Health Research (CHR) is a clinical trial site network that partners with community-based private practices to engage and refer patients to their sites for study enrollment. CHR has been utilizing Aspen Forge to perform recruitment feasibility analyses, identify trial candidates, review the patient-trial match reasoning for each candidate, send verified candidates to the practice for engagement approval, and begin the screening process.

The following two case studies are clear representations of the power of the Aspen Forge tool. It has proven to accelerate the clinical research recruitment process significantly, getting valuable treatments to patients faster and more affordably.

Case Study 1: Endometriosis Study: Patients were matched using Aspen Forge to a clinical trial for endometriosis. The practice was able to review 175 of these high probability candidates. Only 11% of those matches were determined to be unsuitable to reach out to due to various reasons, but out of the 95 patients that were able to be reached by phone 61% of them were interested in the trial and moved forward through the clinical trial enrollment process.

Case Study 2: Adult Migraine Study: Patients were matched using Aspen Forge to a clinical trial for adult migraines. The practice was able to review 52 of these high probability candidates. None of those matches were determined to be unsuitable to reach out to, and out of the 52 patients that were able to be reached by phone 46% of them were interested in the trial and moved forward through the clinical trial enrollment process.
